

Take the awkwardness and difficulty out of cleaning the chamber area of an MSR/AR style rifle with the use of the Star Chamber Cleaning Tool. This tool quickly and effectively cleans the star chamber in just a few twists.

### **How it works**

Extend the handle to clean the star chamber area with the parkerized steel scraper or felt pads. Remove brass nose piece to swap components or to use the 8-32 threaded end.

### **Star Chamber Cleaning Tool**

- Parkerized steel scraper removes fouling build up.
- Coated brass nose piece centers the tool in the chamber of the firearm
- Extendable handle with 8-32 threads, which can accommodate specialized chamber brushes

### **Felt Cleaning Pads**

- Pick up fouling loosened by scraper or can be used to apply solvent.

## **PRIOR TO CLEANING, ENSURE FIREARM IS UNLOADED.**

### **Step 1.**

Remove the Bolt Carrier Group from the upper receiver. For firearm disassembly instructions, refer to your firearm's owner manual.

### **Step 2.**

Assemble scraper and nose on tool.

### **Step 3.**

Extend handle and insert in chamber.

### **Step 4.**

Turn clockwise to scrape fouling in the star chamber area.

### **Step 5.**

Replace scraper with cleaning pad and insert in chamber.

### **Step 6.**

Turn clockwise to pick up loosened fouling left behind by the scraper.

### **Step 7.**

Once clean, place a couple drops of solvent on a new cleaning pad and insert in chamber. Turn clockwise to coat the star chamber area with solvent for added protection.
